
## INTERMODAL DEPOT

## How the project began:

- The parking lot behind Main Street, accessible by Young and Broad Streets, was in critical need of rehabilitation.
- To provide greater benefit to the community, the City was awarded Niagara River Greenway funding to create a place that connects the area's waterways and bike and hike trails while improving parking conditions.

## What it will provide:

- A public plaza within the downtown, close to restaurants and shops.
- Amenities for Blueway and Greenway users, such as docking, rentals and repairs, locker facilities, and wash and rest rooms.
- Improved fire protection for Main Street structures with water pipe upgrades by the Erie County Water Authority.

Grand Opening expected June / July of 2017.

The City of Tonawanda has extraordinary opportunities for recreation, relaxation and revitalization. The Blueways and Greenways Intermodal Depot capitalizes on the City's proximity to the Erie Canal, the Niagara River and Ellicott Creek as well as several major biking and walking trails by providing a centralized community hub within the downtown area.
